



**WATERWISE & SALT TOLERANT PLANTS  
SUITABLE FOR THE  
JUNEE SHIRE COUNCIL  
LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREA**

This list has been prepared to promote plants that are suitable to grow in the Junee Shire Local Government Area; it is by no means an exhaustive list.

The township of Junee has a salinity problem of rising salt in the groundwater. This is most notable in the lower lying areas of the village. The following lists refer to plants that are salt tolerant that would be suitable in this position.

The higher areas around the village are linked to the issue of rising salt, in that these are the places where ground water can be recharged by excess water that escapes back into the ground water table. This in turn contributes to higher ground water levels in the lower lying areas of Junee. Plants that can survive with less water are suitable for these positions and or being mindful of only using water when plants can access it or require it.

**The plants are grouped under the following:**

- 1.0 Large trees (over 8m in height)**
- 2.0 Small trees (less than 8m in height)**
- 3.0 Orchard trees (Various heights and sizes)**
- 4.0 Shrubs**
- 5.0 Ground covers (prostrate plants up to 40cm)**
- 6.0 Grasses and grass like plants**
- 7.0 Perennials**
- 8.0 Lawns**

The plants are listed alphabetically under the common name, with the Botanical name below in italics. Additional information includes; height, spread, salt tolerant, frost tolerant and whether the plant is deciduous or evergreen.

The lists also refer to plants that are (\*) locally native, that meaning that they originate or grow naturally in the Junee area.

There are some warnings (+) given in regards to plants that are poisonous, or which may cause allergies. Ask your local nursery for additional information. Other general warnings include considering the mature height, form and extensive root systems that are often associated with larger trees. These should only be planted where there is ample space.



